

From the Pastor's Desk

Hurricane Harvey Collection:

We all have been watching and reading reports of the devastation and developments following Hurricane Harvey in the southern United States. Our thoughts and prayers continue for everyone involved. When such disasters occur, the U.S. Catholic Church is typically among the first on the scene to assist with relief efforts. That remains true this week. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) and our Bishop Steven J. Raica requested that all parishes do emergency collection to assist the victims of Hurricane Harvey.

In both Saint Monica and Saint Paul Churches, we shall have second collection on the weekend of Sept. 9-10. Funds given to the collection will support the humanitarian and recovery efforts of Catholic Charities USA, the official domestic relief agency of the U.S. Catholic Church, and will provide disaster response and recovery efforts, including direct assistance, rebuilding and health care services.

All checks should be made to the parish, marked for Hurricane Harvey Relief. The parish will issue a single check to the diocese. Donations may also be made through our diocesan website by logging on to dioceseofgaylord.org and then clicking on the link to "Make a Gift." Please be sure to note the donation is for Hurricane Harvey Relief.

More information will be provide in the nearest future if there is need for material support and the possibility for groups to go personally to assist. Let's continue to pray for all those affected as well as the first responders and relief workers who are assisting the Gulf Coast region in countless ways.
