

From the Pastor's Desk

In preparation for the Coming of Our Blessed Mother Mary at Fatima, the Angel of Peace and the Angel of Portugal taught Jacinta, Francisco and Lucia the following prayer:

"My God, I believe, I adore, I hope and I love Thee! I ask pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope and do not love Thee."

"Most Holy Trinity – Father, Son and Holy Spirit- I adore Thee profoundly. I offer Thee the most precious Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ, present in all the tabernacles of the world, in reparation for the outrages, sacrileges, and indifferences whereby He is offended. And through the infinite merits of His Most Sacred Heart and the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I beg of Thee the conversion of poor sinners."

The Fifth Apparition of Our Lady of Fatima took place on September 13, 1917. More than 30,000 people gathered in the Cova the site of the previous apparitions despite the ridicule and jokes of the secular, atheistic press. Whether drawn by devotion or curiosity, they prayed the rosary while awaiting the arrival of the visionaries and their vision. When at last the time came they could hear Lucia say,

"What do you want of me?"

"Continue the Rosary, my children. Say it every day that the war may end. In October Our Lord will come, as well as Our Lady of Sorrows and Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. Saint Joseph will appear with the Child Jesus to bless the world. God is pleased with your sacrifices, but He does not want you to wear the cords to bed. Keep them on during the day."

"I have the petitions of many for your help. Will you assist a little girl who is deaf and dumb?" Lucia asked.

"She will improve within the year."

"And the conversions that some have asked to have brought about? The cures of the sick ones?" Lucia asked.

"Some I will cure, and some I will not. In October I will perform a miracle so that all may believe."

With these last words still ringing in their ears, Our Lady rose and disappeared in the heavens, as Lucia called to the crowd, "If you wish to see her --- look! Look!"

A priest was attending a men's breakfast in farm country. He asked one of the serious looking older farmers to say the grace. After all were seated, the older farmer began, "Lord, I hate buttermilk"

The priest opened one eye and wondered to himself where this was going. Then the farmer loudly proclaimed, "Lord, I hate lard"

So, Lord, when things come up we don't like, when it gets hard, when we just don't understand what you are sayin' to us, help us to just relax and wait 'till You are done mixin'......'cuz it'll probably be somethin' even better than biscuits.
