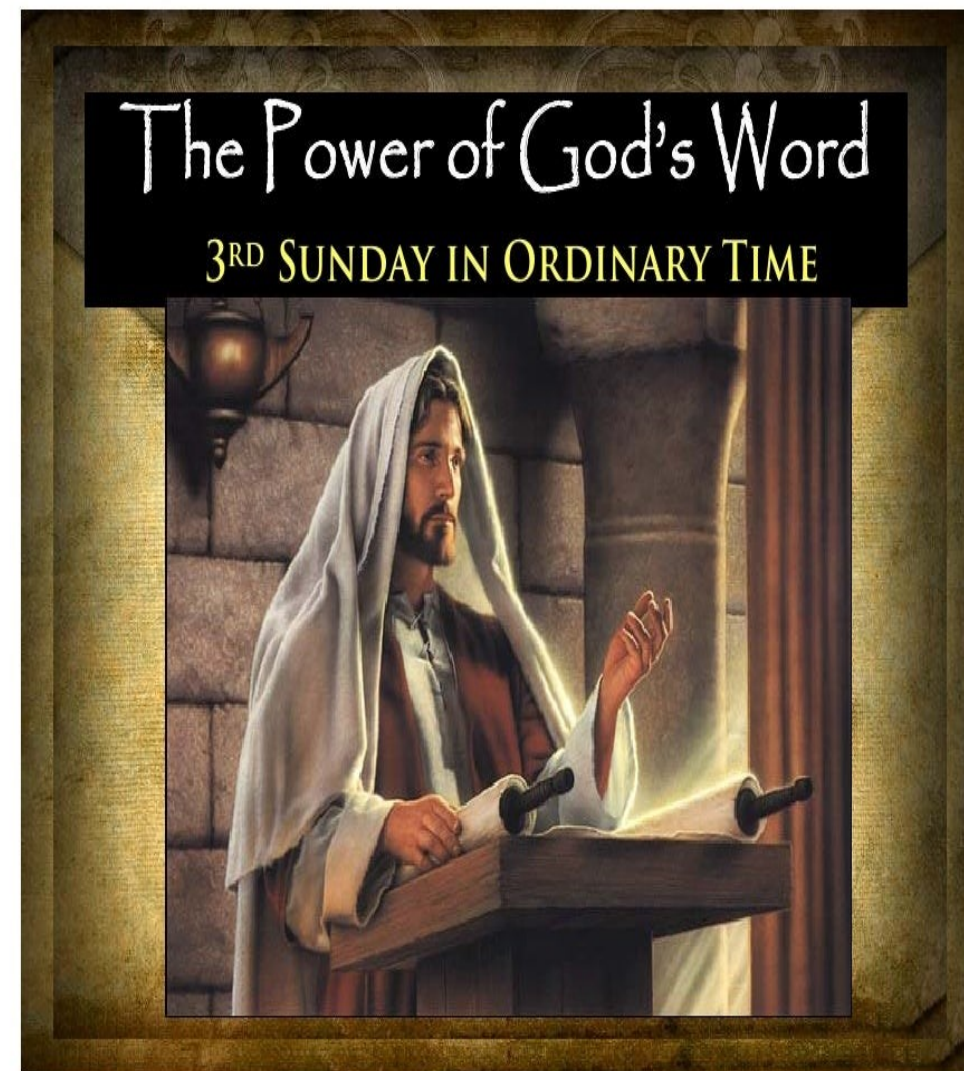

To clarify, Shirley will not be able to tell you when a visit will be. She will take your contact details **ONLY**.


