MISSION STATEMENT

We, the parishioners of St. Paul, Onaway, open to the guidance of the Holy Spirit, are dedicated to preserve, live and proclaim the Good News brought by Jesus. As a sacramental people, we are committed to welcome all into Christ's presence among us.

Dear All,

A few things that I want to let you know about. The most important one is that this Sunday at the Cathedral three of the children will receive their first Holy Communion and Confirmation from the Bishop. What a wonderful thing. Please keep them in your prayers. We pray that we will see them grow older and stronger in the Faith with the parish community. It is the responsibility of the parents and family, such as grandparents, to give them the example of practicing the Faith. Remembering that there is only one, true Church and we will all be judged accordingly. It is our responsibility, as a parish community, to pray for them and, if needed, encourage them to do the right thing.

Next, as we return to Ordinary time, next week, for the weekend Masses, at both parishes, we are going to try to re-introduce Communion under both kinds. I would remind you that to receive Communion under one kind is to receive, FULLY, the body, blood, Soul and Divinity of Our Lord Jesus Christ. You do not have to receive under both kinds. **Reception of the Host IS full Communion.**

To do this we will require extraordinary ministers to sign up in advance. If before Mass begins there are no, or not enough ministers, signed up, Communion will not be under both kinds. There will be no searching out of people and asking them to sign up, or awaiting people to come up at Communion time. No extraordinary ministers from other places are allowed. The Chalice does not travel around the Church. To be clear, if you are immobile and you wish to receive under both kinds you need to sit at the front. If you cannot take the Chalice in TWO hands, then you probably should not be risking the danger of spilling precious Blood.

To begin with we will try two Chalices and increase if needed. The proper way to receive is to respond to, The Blood of Christ, with an Amen. Before you take the Chalice. You are supposed to sip, not gulp, the Precious Blood. If you feel unwell DO NOT approach the Chalice, be considerate. **You have already received the fullness of Communion by receiving the Host.** You are not being deprived of anything. For the months of June, July and August we are going to return to 8am on a Sunday for St Monica. There will be no Sunday evening Mass during those months. I looked at a few other options, but this was the one that was the most practical.

I have been here for less than a year, in that time I am touched by the progress we are making. More and more people regularly using Confession. About 25-30 people come to at least one extra Mass a week. We have a slight increase in volunteers. About 30 people coming to the Adult Faith classes, even though we don't offer food!

However, we need more people to step up as Lectors, as Ushers, and as servers at Mass. I am asking for more servers for St Paul's. I don't really need them at St Monica, but wouldn't refuse, if someone wanted to. But in St Paul's we have three servers. One of whom is not a parishioner. If you are mobile, we could probably use you.

I am asking for people to become more invested in their parish, your Parish. If you want to get onboard, contact Sue in the office. Let her know what you would be willing to help with. If you have volunteered before and it wasn't followed up on, please accept my apologies. If you can only be available from time to time, that doesn't matter. If you are new and not sure, glad to have you.
